- The age for the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation & Holy Communion will be the age of reason, or generally 7 years of age.
- Parents are the primary educators of children in the Catholic faith and should take an active part in their child's First Reconciliation & Holy Communion preparation
- Parents should make every effort to attend Mass with their children on a regular basis to give witness to the faith and to fulfill their weekend Mass obligation as laid out by Pope Paul VI.
- Families should make every attempt to register in the parish – This may be done at the same time as registration for the Faith Formation classes for your convenience.
- Students must attend the required Faith Formation classes on Wednesday nights in addition to the required Sacramental classes.
- A Parent/Guardian must present a copy of their Baptismal Certificate of the student to receive Holy Communion for our records *if not done previously*.
- Students will be prepared to receive both the sacraments of First Reconciliation & Holy Communion.
